## **Discontinuing a Professional Medical Corporation**

Section 31 (4) and (5) of the Medical Act, 2011 (the "Act") provides as follows:

- A corporation shall not use the words "professional medical corporation" or an abbreviation
  of those words as part of its corporate name unless it is registered and licensed as a
  professional medical corporation under this Act; and
- A corporation shall not provide the services of a medical practitioner unless it is registered and licensed under this Act.

Therefore, a Professional Medical Corporation not duly registered and licensed with the College is required to complete one of the following options:

- 1. File Articles of Amendment with the Registry of Companies for the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador to:
  - o change the name of the corporation to remove any reference to a "Professional Medical Corporation" (or an abbreviation of those words); and
  - o amend the services the corporation may provide, to remove the language restricting the services to those of a medical practitioner or related matters.
- 2. Voluntarily dissolve the corporation with the Registry of Companies for the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador.
- 3. Continue (transfer) the corporation with the Registry of Companies for the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador to another jurisdiction.
