



## CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES ACT – EXPANDED DUTY TO REPORT

### Notice to College Members

The Department of Health and Community Services has requested that we circulate information to College Members regarding the expanded duty to report under the *Children, Youth and Families Act* (CYFA).

Under the new CYFA, physicians are required to report immediately to a manager, social worker, or peace officer if they have information that a child (under the age of 16) or a youth (age 16-17) is or may be in need of protective intervention.
